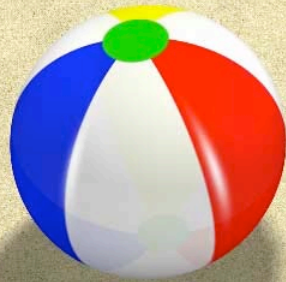


Development of a web based GIS information portal focused on the increased beneficial reuse of recyclable materials with a focus on traditional and non-traditional local disposal options.



Innovative Grant Summary

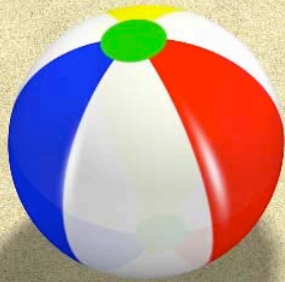

- Using GIS technology, this portal would show the locations of all types of Solid Waste Facilities (e.g., landfills, waste to energy facilities, recycling centers, household hazardous waste centers, MRFs, tire processors, etc.)

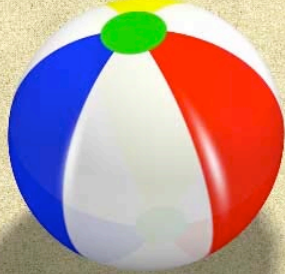


- It would allow the general public to find convenient local disposal facilities and get directions to them.
